Parent Code of Conduct

- I will participate in the Y's approved communication systems; REMIND, Facebook and email.
- I will require my child to treat other swimmers, coaches, fans, and officials with respect without regard to gender, race, religion, culture, or ability.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by giving positive support to all swimmers, parents, coaches and officials at every meet, practice, or other event.
- I will support and assist this experience however I can by being respectful to other team parents, coaches, and volunteering for activities throughout the season.
- I will support coaches and officials by working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all. If I have concerns, I will schedule a meeting with the Head Coach.
- I will refrain from the use of tobacco, alcohol, and drugs at all swim practices, meets, and other team events and I will encourage others to do the same.
- I will bring areas of concern or safety for my child and the team as a whole directly to the Head Coach to address them promptly and not leave the location the occurrence took place.
- I will have my child participate in additional team activities; team fundraising, team bonding, etc.
- I will attend parent meetings and if a parent is unable to attend, I will review the parent meeting minutes posted on the team website and sign off on them in the Parent Swim Binder.
- As a family unit one parent will volunteer or participate during the season.
